Greetings Honorable Tribal Leaders and Tribal Partners:

SUBJECT: Informational- Potential agency request legislation for cottage food operations

In accordance with chapter 43.376 RCW, the Washington State Centennial Accord of 1989, and DOH Consultation and Collaboration Procedure, I am writing today to provide information about potential 2025 agency request legislation to amend chapter 69.22 RCW, which regulates cottage food operations.

These businesses are operated by persons who produce cottage food products only in the home kitchen of that person's primary domestic residence in Washington and only for sale directly to the consumer. The cottage food program and rulemaking are currently within the authority of Washington State Department of Agriculture. The agency request legislation would shift oversite authority and rulemaking authority of Cottage Food Operations to the Department of Health. Cottage Food Operations – Proposed Legislation | Washington State Department of Health. This will help us direct our food safety and community engagement efforts with those who want to sell food prepared in home kitchens.
